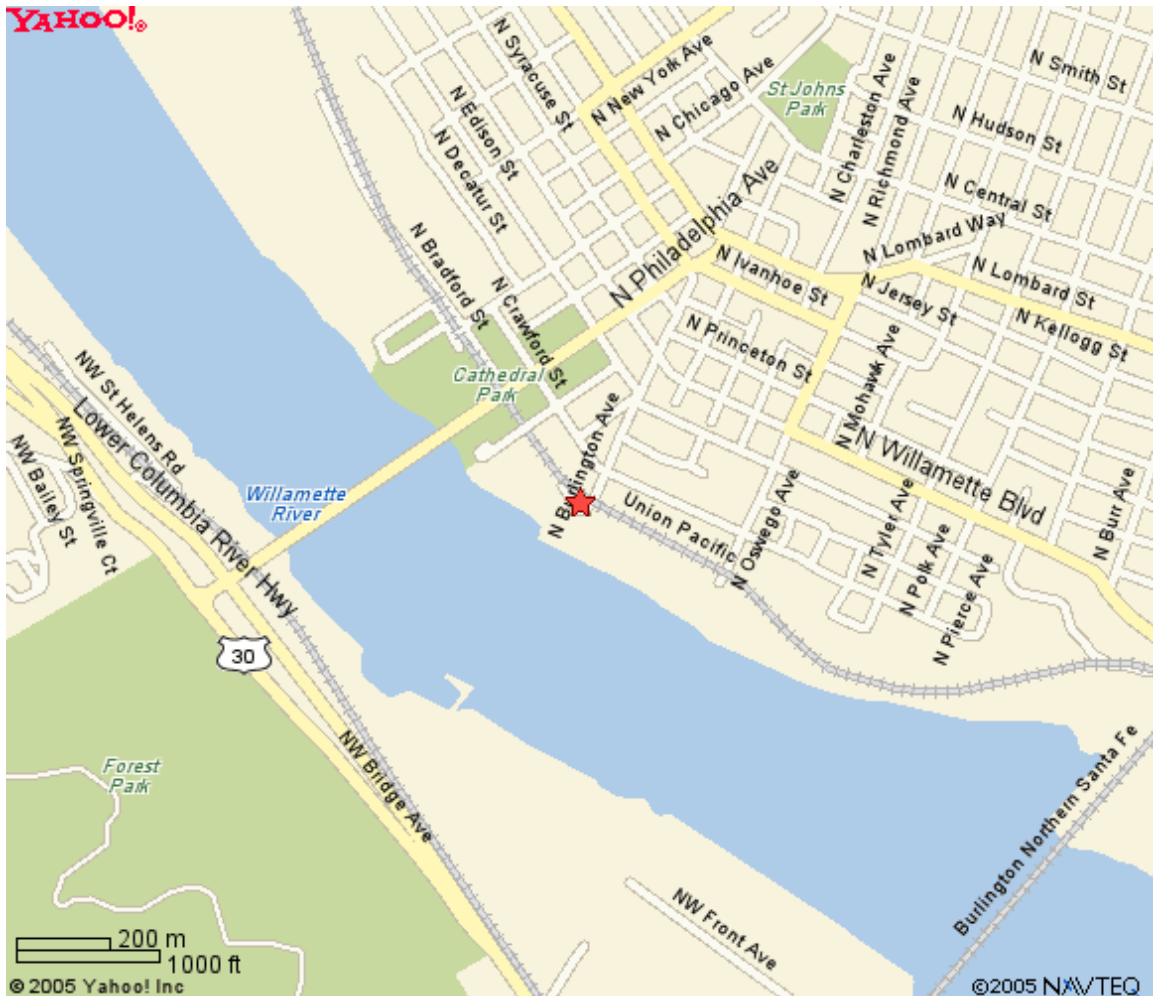

I-405 NORTH toward US 30 WEST

Take **L** exit #3 onto **US-30 WEST** toward **ST. HELENS** - go 1.0 mi

Continue on **NW YEON AVE** - go 2.0 mi

Continue on **NW ST HELENS RD** - go 2.0 mi

Bear **L** on **NW BRIDGE AVE[US-30-BYP]** - go 0.6 mi

Bear **R** to follow **US-30-BYP WEST** - go 0.7 mi

Turn **R** on **N SYRACUSE ST** - go < 0.1 mi

Turn **R** on **N BURLINGTON AVE** - go 0.3 mi

Arrive at **6543 N BURLINGTON AVE, PORTLAND**, on the **R**
